- Minimum 3.0 overall GPA
- Unofficial transcripts (high school transcripts if high school student or 1st year college student, otherwise, college transcripts only)
- 500 1,000 word essay on soil (you may choose to address topics separately or together)
 - Significance and importance of soil
 - One or both of the following topics:
 - a) Goals for career objectives relating to soil
 - b) Personal interest in studying or enhancing/protecting soil

Applicant deadline: Please submit all materials by April 17, 2020 by 5PM PST. Recipient will be notified by May 18, 2020
